## INVITATION TO BID Snow Removal

The City of Lyndon, Kentucky is requesting bids for snow removal. Contract work begins January 1, 2020 through December 31, 2020.

Sealed bids are to be received **NO LATER** than **3:00 p.m. September 16**, **2019** at the office of City Clerk, Lyndon City Hall, 515 Wood Road, Lyndon, Kentucky 40222. Bids will be opened at the September 16, 2019 Caucus Meeting at 6:00 p.m.

The contract shall be awarded to the bidder with the lowest evaluated bid price. The lowest evaluated bid price shall mean the dollar amount of a bid after bid price adjustments are made pursuant to objective measurable criteria, which affect the economy and effectiveness in the operation in full accord with the Kentucky Model Procurement Act. Proof of insurance and hold harmless agreement must be submitted.

Council reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

## **SNOW REMOVAL**

Lyndon will contract for snow removal for the year of 2020. In general, any snowfall less than 2 inches in depth is handled by salt. Should the temperature be such that salt is not effective, then plowing may be authorized. **The City of Lyndon will purchase all salt.** 

For snowfalls totaling 2-4 inches in depth, Lyndon will authorize plowing of all major intersections as well as problem areas and through roads such as Ormsby Lane, Holly Springs Drive, Wood Road, and other streets as shown on the accompanying map. Snowfall above 4 inches will call for plowing all streets to keep at least one lane open (all major thoroughfares to get first attention).

Extenuating circumstances may require some adjustments to the plan as outlined. Authorization would be required from the Mayor in those cases. Hand Labor is required at cul-de-sac driveway curbs if plowing results in excessive accumulation at said driveways.

There are a number of private roads in the City of Lyndon. None of these are maintained through the City Snow Removal Plan. They are: Birk Lane, Catherine Avenue, Warwick Avenue (8000 block, West of Lyndon Ln.) Perry Road (off Wood Rd.) and Powerhouse Lane. Also, roads in most patio home developments including: Holly Pointe, Lyndon Lakes, Pinehurst Green and Windsor Place and all streets located in apartment complexes are excluded from this bid.

Please include in the bid whether the City of Lyndon will be your first priority and the amount of time it will take to begin service after notification by Lyndon of the need for snow removal. Also, please submit a renewal price for a second-year option. Bidders are required by specification to submit a comprehensive and inclusive bid price which covers any and all costs of services, including but not limited to fuel.
