A motion was made by Amy Stuber to amend the amount from \$10,000 to \$8,000 (\$4,000 for Medical Alert and \$4,000 for meals), seconded by Carla Nalley, motion carried unanimously. A motion made by Amy Stuber and seconded by Carla Nalley to approve Municipal Order #8-26-19B as amended. Motion carried with 6 "aye", 1 "abstain", 0 "nays".
