

**CITY OF LYNDON
CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 16, 2020**

The Caucus Meeting was called to order by Mayor Brent Hagan at 6:00 p.m. Those present: Susan Barto, Betsy Kramer, Kelly Kramer, Carla Nalley, Becky Ricketts, Mardy Sidebottom, Amy Stuber and City Attorney John Singler. One guest was present.


Mayor Hagan presented Resolution #11-23-20 which will be on agenda Monday night in order to conclude the application process for CARES Grant. Application has been submitted and this resolution will open reimbursement process. Discussion was held. Mayor also brought up Arbor Day is arriving soon. Trees will be planted at two locations for the celebration. More details to come on when this will take place and photo will be taken. Amy Stuber brought up a few of the ID plates have fallen at Romara and inquired about dead tree removal. Mayor Hagan made note of the plates and will have them reattached.

Dirk Gowin from Metro Public Works will be attending the council meeting to explain a 3-phase road improvement project in Lyndon. Discussion was held.

A few other topics were discussed. Mr. Ed Haines from Autumn Ridge mentioned a milling machine sitting at the corner of Ormsby and Lagrange. The Mayor stated he will follow-up. Ms. Ricketts inquired about Washington neighborhood status. Mayor Hagan informed council there was a neighborhood meeting and will find out more details. He also mentioned the property has not yet been acquired by prospective developer. Purchase is pending on the outcome of this development case. Amy Stuber made a report of streetlight outage and crime reports were also discussed. Ms. Ricketts asked if she could look at recent crime reports. The Mayor stated he will provide any that are requested.


December Council Meeting will be on the 21st and swearing-in ceremony will also take place.
