

**CITY OF LYNDON  
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, NOVEMBER 22, 2021**

Mayor Brent Hagan called the Council Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Susan Barto, Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Camie Popham, Becky Ricketts, Mardy Sidebottom, Amy Stuber and City Attorney, John Singler.

A motion was made by Becky Ricketts, seconded by Amy Stuber to approve the minutes of the October 25, 2021 Council Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Susan Barto, seconded by Betsy Kramer to approve the minutes of the November 15, 2021 Caucus Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

The Treasurer's Report was given and will be filed for audit. Balance for November 1, 2021 was \$5,659,549.01.

**MUNICIPAL ORDER 11-22-21- Case No. 21-MSUB-0006 – Waivers approval for major preliminary plan at end of Etawah Ave.** - Mayor Hagan introduced Derrick Triplett from Land Design and Development who presented the plan and waivers Louisville Metro Planning Commission recommended to Lyndon Council to review and take action. Discussion was held. City Attorney John Singler explained the waivers for council to make motions. A motion was made by Susan Barto and seconded by Carla Nalley to approve waiver, section 7.3.30 to allow lots for detached homes to not abut a public street. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Camie Popham, seconded by Betsy Kramer to approve waiver, section 5.8 to not provide sidewalks within public ROW although the recommendation from Metro Louisville was to deny the waiver. Motion carried unanimously.

**ANNOUNCEMENTS:** Light Up Lyndon is December 5<sup>th</sup> from 4pm- 7pm. Santa will be there at 5:30pm. Mayor Hagan also announced next Caucus Meeting is cancelled and Council Meeting will take place of Caucus on December 20, 2021, at 6:00p.m.


**OTHER BUSINESS:** The Mayor informed council the ARPA refund the City received was miscalculated by the Department of Local Government and the City had to pay back \$664,000. Discussion was held. The City did receive \$1500 from KLC for a Insurance Safety Liability Grant for sidewalk projects. Also, Arbor Day will be celebrated next month. The Mayor has a few trees he has been taking care of that will be planted at the park to honor the day.

Mayor distributed alternative plans for the Lyndon Park Lane section of Robsion Park with renderings of two examples of a large pavilion. Discussion was held. Ms. Sidebottom asked about the outdoor restroom at Romara and Mayor Hagan stated he is waiting on quote which he should have by December meeting.
