

**CITY OF LYNDON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, JULY 26, 2021**

A motion was made by Becky Ricketts, seconded by Amy Stuber to elect Susan Barto as Mayor Pro Tem in the absence of Brent Hagan.

A second reading and action will take place at the August council meeting.


