

**CITY OF LYNDON  
CAUCUS MEETING MINUTES  
MONDAY, AUGUST 15, 2022**

Mayor Brent Hagan called the Council Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. Those present: Susan Barto, Betsy Kramer, Carla Nalley, Camie Popham, Becky Ricketts, Mardy Sidebottom, Amy Stuber and City Attorney, John Singler. One guest was also present.

Mayor Hagan informed council of two Resolutions that will be on the agenda for next Monday. The first is pertaining to participation in the Kentucky Public Employees' Deferred Compensation Authority for police officers and the second is for the Kentucky Public Pension Authority for hazardous coverage. Also, a Municipal Order will be on agenda for approval of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement with Graymoor- Devondale to provide 3 years of police protection in lieu of payment for all assets of the police department.

Mayor Hagan mentioned the police vehicles the City purchased have been assigned and they are in use. Grady Throneberry, Chief of Police, spoke to council and answered questions regarding the transition. He also spoke about the new Deputy Chief, Rob Schroeder who was recently hired. He was a former Louisville Police Chief. Discussion was held.



Mardy Sidebottom inquired about timeframe of Ormsby street improvements. Mayor informed her the design company still has not come to City with plan. Mayor Hagan also stated the deed of restriction for Lyndon Park Lane was signed and delivered to Pluris. They can begin initiating plan.
