

**CITY OF LYNDON
COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES
MONDAY, OCTOBER 23, 2023**

Councilwoman, Susan Barto called the Council Meeting to order at 6:00 p.m. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Those present: Susan Barto, Betsy Kramer, Becky Ricketts, Mardy Sidebottom, Vicki Stanley, Amy Stuber and City Attorney, John Singler. Carla Nalley was absent.

In the absence of Mayor, Brent Hagan, a motion was made by Becky Ricketts, seconded by Amy Stuber, to appoint Susan Barto as Mayor Pro Tem. Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made by Mardy Sidebottom, seconded by Vicki Stanley to approve the minutes of the September 25, 2023 Council Meeting. Motion carried unanimously. A motion was made by Amy Stuber, seconded by Mardy Sidebottom to approve the minutes of the October 16, 2023 Caucus Meeting. Motion carried unanimously.

City Attorney, John Singler, read the Treasurer's Report which will be filed for audit. Ending balance for October 1, 2023 was \$4,872,527.87.


LEAF REMOVAL BID: The City advertised for bids for the 2023 Leaf Removal and received one bid from Miller Mowing and Landscaping. The bid was opened last week at the Caucus Meeting and Mr. Singler read the amount, \$79,300. Mr. Singler also mentioned the City reached out to Mr. Miller about honoring the same amount for the second and third year renewal as mentioned in the specifications. Mr. Miller agreed to honor the price as long as fuel charges don't drastically increase. A motion was made by Becky Ricketts, seconded by Amy Stuber to approve the bid from Miller Mowing & Landscaping. Motion carried unanimously. Discussion was held.
