#### **Grant Funding**

Governor Andy Beshear presented Chief Schroeder and Mayor Hagan a check for \$26,483 from the Law **Enforcement Protection** Program, a grant by the Department of Homeland Security. This money has been



allocated for non-lethal tasers and their accessories for all of our sworn officers.

Additionally, the Governor announced \$876,000 in funding to make safety improvements to LaGrange Road. The LaGrange Road Corridor project will introduce more "complete street" features, like bike lanes and sidewalks, to improve connectivity and safety for cyclists and pedestrians. New turn lanes will improve efficiency and reduce emissions. The funds come from KYTC's Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality program. This project has been discussed for over a decade and is not managed by the City of Lyndon.

#### Fallen Trees- Who is the responsible party?

This has always been a frequently asked question for City Hall. Lately, with so many wind events, we want to remind property owners of this important information. When a tree falls on your property, no matter where the tree originates from, the debris and associated damage to your property is your responsibility. It may be as easy as cleaning up a few branches or much worse. If you are dealing with a hefty cost for repairs, you would need to file a claim with your insurance company to cover the damage or cleanup.

If a tree was diseased or dead and the owner neglected to maintain it, it could be the property owner or their insurer's responsibility. The first step is to call your insurance company to get their advice on what you need to do next. If there is a claim against you, you should also call your insurance company for the best solution.



#### **Short-Term Rentals**

Lyndon Council recently approved an ordinance defining and regulating all short-term rentals within city limits. These include Air B&Bs, VRBO rentals and other listings on hosting platforms that advertise a dwelling unit that is rented, leased or otherwise assigned for a tenancy of less than 30 consecutive days. Short-term rentals are ONLY allowed in R-6, R-7, R-8, OR-1, OR-1, OR-3, C-N, C-R, C-1 and C-2 zoning districts and must be permitted in accordance with special standards.
