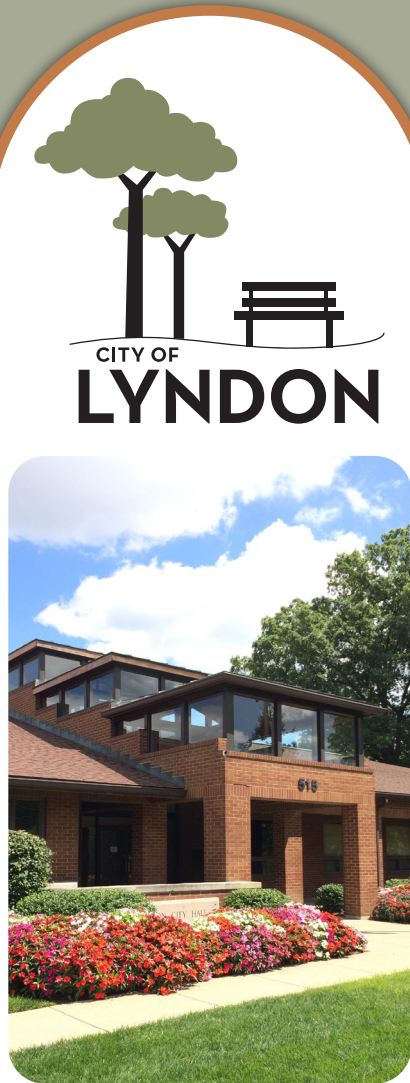

Mayor's Message

In the last 8 months, I have spoken many times about our new Police Department. There are aspects of operating a Police Department that a City may believe it is fully prepared for and positioned to handle as issues arise. From the beginning we debated the rationale and cost-effective reasons for acquiring our neighbor department. We assessed all available options for meeting the community's policing needs, including alternative ways to provide all or select services as well as what resources we had available to convert into police use. Style of policing is also a very important piece to consider. How should our citizens be policed?

Since August 1, 2022, I have had the unique and unprecedented opportunity to evaluate an existing police organization transfer to a new name and employer under my watch. These things are true, it is time consuming and expensive! On a serious note, I have spent a lot of time getting to know our officers, community partners, contract Cities and what our community needs from the Lyndon Police. While we are constantly working to improve and expand upon the previous department, one action needed to be taken, change in leadership. This is old news to many of you. Due to the cycle of our newsletters this is the first time I've been able to address you in this form of media. The Lyndon City council approved the appointment of former Deputy Chief Robert Schroeder, to Chief and former Major Christopher Thomas was promoted to Deputy. I believe our officers are now in a better position to police our community in a more responsive and impactful manner.

Chief Schroeder has many talents, including significant leadership and law enforcement experience. He is someone that will work to build partnerships, work collaboratively with all members of our community, and who will continue to move the Police Department forward to provide excellent public service every day.
